Scholarship Regulations for International Students at International Specialization Class by Central Taiwan University of Science and Technology and Ministry of Education

- 1. In accordance with the needs of the national industry and the policy of the Ministry of Education (MOE), Central Taiwan University of Science and Technology (hereinafter referred to as the University) cooperates with the Ministry of Education to organize the international specialization classes, with the purpose of assist foreign students in the international class to successfully complete their studies and live in Taiwan, a set of "Scholarship Regulations for International Students at International Specialization Class by Central Taiwan University of Science and Technology and Ministry of Education" (referred to as these regulations).
- 2. Foreign students referred to in these regulations mean International Students in the New Southbound Industry Academia Cooperation Program, Two-years Long-Term Healthcare Field International Specialized Program, International Foundation Progran, 5+2 Key Industries International Program, International Students for International Specialized Programs (excluding Vocational Education Program for Overseas Compatriot Student Programs and Four-year Academia Cooperative Degree Overseas Youth Vocational Training Program (OYVTP).
- 3. Scholarship Amount and Disbursement Method
 - (1) Scholarship Amount
 - Four-Year Degree Program: Each registered student will receive a scholarship of total 80,000 NTD, which will be awarded in 8 semesters and directly deducted from the tuition and miscellaneous fees, with a deduction of 10,000 NTD per semester. If a student withdraws from the semester, the scholarship will not be continued or renewed. Students in the 1+4 program (1 year of Chinese preparatory program and 4 years of Bachelor's degree program) will not be awarded this scholarship in the first year learning Chinese Language because their tuition and miscellaneous fees have been reduced.
 - Two-Year Degree Program: Each registered student is granted a scholarship of 30,000 NTD distributed in 4 semesters, and directly deducted from the tuition fees, with a deduction of 7,500 NTD each semester.
 - (2) Scholarship Renewal Requirements: Students must participate in international activities organized by the school's Office of Admissions and International Cooperation at least twice in the previous semester and have no disciplinary record in order to continue receiving the scholarship.
 - (3) The list of scholarship recipients is compiled by the Office of Admissions and International Cooperation and submitted to the Admissions Committee meeting for review. After approval of the review, it is sent directly to the Accounting Office as the basis for tuition fee reduction or waiver.
- 4. The regulations shall be implemented after being approved by the Executive Council Meeting, and the same

applies when making amendments.
