

# Scholarship Regulations for International Students of Central Taiwan University of Science and Technology

Article 1. To promote international exchanges, attract outstanding foreign students to study at our school, and assist them in completing their studies during the period of enrollment to graduation smoothly, these regulations are hereby established.

Article 2. Objects and Quotas: Individuals with foreign nationality who have not obtained ROC nationality and do not have the status of overseas Chinese students when applying; or students who meet the qualifications to apply for admission as foreign students at our university. The total amount of scholarship for new students admitted each academic year (excluding returning students) shall not exceed one million New Taiwan Dollars. The total number of scholarship recipients each academic year is twenty. The number of scholarship quotas for each college will be allocated according to the ratio of the number of foreign students enrolled in each college divided by the total number of foreign students applying for admission, including master's degree, doctoral degree, and undergraduate programs.

Article 3. Scholarship Amount and Number of Awards:

1. The scholarship amount provided to the award-winning students for the academic year is Fifty Thousand New Taiwan Dollars. The scholarship will be disbursed at the end of November of that year and the end of May of the following year, with half of the scholarship for that academic year disbursed each time.
2. The list of scholarship recipients will be reviewed by the responsible department of the institute, and the budget will be requested by the Office

of Admissions and International Cooperation.

Article 4. Scholarship Duration: 1 year. Newly awarded students who do not register for admission in that year or take a leave of absence shall forfeit their scholarship eligibility and may not apply for retention or extension.

Article 5. Requirements for students receiving scholarship: Students must participate in enrollment, international cooperation, and overseas Chinese community activities with an attendance rate of 80% or above each semester.

Article 6. Students who meet the admission requirements will be automatically considered for scholarship eligibility without the separate application.

Article 7. The necessary expenses of this regulation shall be allocated from the school's relevant budget.

Article 8. If a student suspends their studies during the semester, any scholarships received for that semester shall not be recovered. If the scholarships for that semester has not been disbursed yet, it shall be suspended immediately.

Article 9. Other Notes:

1. If a scholarship recipient is found to have forged, altered, or provided false information, their scholarship qualification shall be revoked, and the received scholarship funds shall be recovered.
2. Foreign students who have already received scholarships from government departments are not eligible to receive this scholarship again.

Article 10. These regulations shall be implemented after approval by the executive meeting, and amendments shall follow the same procedure.
